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Vendor Rules/Guideline

Please read these rules carefully and keep them close at hand to refer to, in order to help keep Art in the Park safe and enjoyable for all, vendors and customers. Please include a working email address when filling out your application.

Vendors may not sublet or transfer space to others.

Canopy will be provided by CREATE. A banner will mark the area of Creative Kids, no additional banners are permitted to be hung on the canopy. Vendor materials must stay under the canopy space.

Keeping the Park Clean

Vendors must keep their space clean and attractive during event hours and must clean up their space after the event closes, including removing trash. If you believe sale of your product will generate waste, you should plan appropriate materials to clean up.

All vendors MUST HAUL OUT THEIR TRASH at the end of the day. On site trash receptacles are for guests use only.

Etiquette

Vendors are responsible for making sure that all persons working at their booth are familiar with and adhere to all event rules.

Vendors' booths, tables, and signs shall not be a hazard to the public or to other vendors.

Early departures are not permitted. No vehicle operations are allowed during event hours without CREATE board member escort.

Each booth space must prominently display a sign clearly identifying its name. All product descriptions must be accurate.

Vendors are NOT allowed to smoke in their booths.

Only products listed on the vendor application will be permitted to be sold without prior permission from the CREATE Board Member.

There is no loud hawking of goods. Booth set-up will be between 12 noon-12:45 pm on Saturday June 17th, 2017

Late arriving vendors may have to park their vehicle outside the market area for unloading and carry their supplies to their booth.

Space Assignments

Vendors are responsible for tables and chairs needed to work their space as well as any additional items to create and attractive display. Tables should not exceed 8 feet in length. Each vendor will be allotted a 10' x 5' area. Please keep goods, tables, chairs within this space throughout the event.

There will be room for vehicles to unload at the canopy. Vehicles must be move prior to the start of the event. The vendors will have to park off in designated parking areas away from the canopy.

All spaces must be paid for to be occupied. Reservations are confirmed when payment has been received. Determination of space designation will be made by the Art in the Park Manager and is subject to change.

Pets No pets, please.

Product Guidelines

All products must be grown, raised, produced or made by the vendor or family member in the state of Pennsylvania. Products which can be sold at the event include: vegetables, fruits, berries, herbs, flowers, honey, plants, eggs, dairy products and value added items which are grown and/or made by the vendor, such as cheese, preserved foods, and baked goods.

Handmade crafts, art and products will be juried in advance by the CREATE board members. Vendors will provide a detailed description of their featured products on the application as well as present at least one sample at a determined date.

- a. Vendors may be asked to provide a written verification as to the source of the components of their products.
- b. The Art in the Park does not offer exclusive rights to any one vendor to sell any one product. If the number of vendors offering the same or similar products is excessive, duplicate products may be denied entry.
- c. All products shall be of the highest quality. No imports, kits, multilevel marketing, commercial, franchise or second hand items are permitted. If you order the final product through a catalog, it is not allowed.
- d. Art in the Park is not a forum for political or religious activities. Space will not be issued to persons or organizations wishing to campaign or proselytize.
- e. Live animals may not be sold, traded, or given away at the event.
- f. There will be no discrimination as to race, creed, color, gender, religion, sexual orientation, age, nationality, marital status, or the presence of any sensory, mental or physical disability.
